

NON-SURRENDER OF VACANT ALL INDIA QUOTA POST-GRADUATE SEATS 2014

In compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in IA No. 15/2014 in Writ Petition No 433/2013 in Dr Fraz Naseem & Ors Vs Union of India & Ors the vacant Post-graduate Seats of All India Quota 2014, shall not be surrendered (reverted back) to State / Universities as notified earlier in Counseling schedule on 19.06.2014.

Therefore, States/Universities may please note that vacant Post-graduate Seats of All India Quota 2014 must not be included in State /University Quota for allotment.

Facility for reporting online resignation will remain available till 25th June 2014.

UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

I.A. No. 15/2014 in Writ Petition (Civil) No(s). 433/2013

By means of this application, a modification of Order dated 14th March, 2014 is sought for. By means of that order, following schedule had been prescribed, which we may emphasis by a third round of counseling.

It appears that, as is averred in the application, five States has yet not completed the second round of counseling, which exercise was to be completed by 3rd May, 2014 whereby enabling the All India Quota to be acted upon on or before 19th May, 2014.

Mr. Maninder Singh, learned Additional Solicitor General draws our attention to the decision of a three judge bench of this Court in Neelu Arora (Ms.) and another versus Union of India and others [(2003) 3 SCC 366], which categorically contemplates the holding of only two counseling. This has subsequently been followed by two judge bench of this Court in Priya Gupta versus State of Chhattisgarh and others [(2012) 7 SCC 433].

Because of alleged non-adherence to the schedule prescribed in the order dated 14th March, 2014, modification thereof has been necessitated. Learned counsel appearing for the States of Maharashtra and Gujarat state that the first round of counseling

has already been completed and there are no vacancies. As far as the other three States, namely, Assam, Bihar and Madhya Pradesh are concerned, we direct that the second counseling, if necessary, shall be completed by 23rd June, 2014. These States shall specifically and categorically mention the vacancies that have arisen even subsequent to the second counseling. Since the students are expected to act as per the choice indicated by them in the second counseling, one further day would be required for their paying the requisite fees, etc. In other words, by 25th June, 2014, it would be clear as to how many vacancies have arisen on that date. Accordingly, the candidates in the All India Quota will thereafter exercise their choice by way of extended third round of counseling which shall have to be completed by 27th June, 2014. Since the commencement of the Academic Session is contemplated on 30th June, 2014 for the Academic Year 2014-2015, this will enable the States to fill up the vacancies that may result from the All India Quota not being utilized. This will also safeguard the interests of the institutions concerned who are logically aggrieved by the fact that the seats should not go unutilized in any institution. Adequate publicity by way of advertisement as well as on the website shall be carried out by all the States concerned.

We clarify that the last date for joining of candidates allotted seats in the All India Quota, which has been fixed on 19th June, 2014, stands modified by the schedule laid down by us in the present order.

I.A. No.15 is disposed of in the above terms.
