This is in reference to the action taken by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare arising out of Gazette Notification dated 12.07.2018 regarding the conversion of Diploma seats to degree seats.

In this regard, the process followed by the Council includes rapid screening followed by the current information provided by the institution ascertain that the institution fulfills the minimum norms for this conversion.

Keeping in view of the above, all participating Colleges/ Institutes in the NEET- PG 2019 counselling for 50% All India Quota and 100% Central Universities/ Deemed Universities seats are hereby informed that there is the real possibility that some of the institutions may not meet the benchmarks required for conversion of Diploma to Degree seats. In that scenario, some colleges may end up with having neither the diploma seats (having been de-notified) nor the converted PG degree seats. This may lead an overall loss of PG seats to the institution.

Hence, in aforementioned such cases the institutions are advised not to contribute such Diploma seats (sent for de-notification) to MCC/DGHS for online PG: 2019 counselling and whose conversion to Degree course was still not received by the institution/colleges or is in the pending stage. Furthermore, in case college contributes such Diploma seats (denotified) to this directorate then respective college/institute shall stands responsible category of for such and any seats legal complication/litigation/ adverse situation arising out in the matter would be the dealt individuality by the respective college/institute.
