ADMISSION NOTICE FOR POST-DOCTORAL (SUPERSPECIALITY— DM/MCh) COURSES FOR YEAR 2017

1. Armed Forces Medical Services conduct Post –doctoral/ super speciality training primarily for the doctors of Armed Forces Medical Services. The candidates eligible to participate for DM/MCh seats at AFMC Pune are (In order of preference):-

(a) Serving officers of the AFMS granted study leave.

(b) Medical Officers sponsored by Para Military Forces/ other Govt of India organizations. Sponsor's certificate issued by the sponsoring authority, should be specific to one subject only and is mandatory requirement for the candidate to be considered for counseling.

(c) Ex-SSC AFMS officers released from service after completion of contractual service, within three years after the release from service i.e. the date of release should not be before 01 August 2014 or after 31Jul 2017 for the session starting from August 2017. Officers who have resigned the commission/dismissed /removed from service/ not completed the contractual service are **NOT ELIGIBLE** under this category.

(d) Civilian doctors willing to serve in the Armed Forces Medical Services (AFMS) for 05 years subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria. Candidate will have to execute a bond agreement to pay a sum of **Rs. Thirty Three Lacs (Rs. 33,00,000/-)** to Govt of India at the time of admission in case unwilling to join AFMS when offered com mission on completion of the course) in that order under the provisions of Govt of India letter F/PC-8510/DGAFMS/DG-1D/ 345/2013/D/(Med) dated 6th March 2013 and GOI letter No: PCIII/17436/DGAFMS/DG1D/ 1819/ 13/(a)/D (Medical) dated 15 January 2014.

2. <u>SEATS & RECOGNITION STATUS</u>: AFMC Pune is recognized by the Medical Council of India (MCI) and is affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for the following super speciality courses:-

- (a) DM (Cardiology) : 01(Recognized)
- (b) MCh (CTVS Surgery) : 03 (01 seat recognized & 02 seats permitted)
- (c) MCh (Neurosurgery) : 03 (All recognized)
- (d) MCh (Plastic Surgery) : 03 (All recognized)

3. <u>ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</u>: The following eligibility criteria shall be applicable:-

- (a) Age criteria:-
 - (i) <u>AFMS Officers:</u> As per extant training rules of AFMS.
 - (ii) <u>Sponsored candidates:</u> As per Govt of India rules.
 - (iii) <u>Ex-SSC AFMS officers</u> : Maximum permissible age shall be 40 yrs as on 01 Aug 2017.
 - (iv) <u>Civilian candidates</u>: Maximum permissible age will be 40 years as on 01 Aug 2017.

(b) Candidate must have MBBS & MD/MS/DNB Degrees registered with State Medical Council or MCI. Stu

dents who have completed/ are completing post-graduation by 31 Jul 2017 are eligible to apply along with Provision al registration certificate.

(c) The candidate must be a citizen of India.

(d) A candidate who is already pursuing any superspeciality course shall not be eligible for admission to another superspeciality course in the Academic Year 2017-2018.

(f) The number of candidates to be admitted in any discipline will be determined by the number of Superspeciality teachers available, the student-teacher ratio and any other criteria laid down by the Medical Council of India and MUHS, Nashik, University from time to time. The exact number of available seats will be communicated at the time of counseling.

4. <u>COUNSELING</u>: As per the Govt of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare letter No. V.26012/02/2016-MEP (Pt) dated 04 May 2017; there shall be a common counseling for all seats of NEET – Super Speciality at National level to be conducted by Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS). Hence, all eligible candidates desirous of admission to Post-doctoral courses (DM/ MCh) at Armed Forces Medical College (AFMC), Pune for the session commencing from Aug 2017 will have to register on portal for Superspeciality courses on website: **www.mcc.nic.in**. **ARMED FORCES MEDICAL COLLEGE, PUNE**

5. PROCESS OF ADMISSION AND MEDICAL EXAMINATION

The following process will be adopted by candidates:-

(a) All candidates seeking admission should register on the portal for Superspeciality courses on website:

www.mcc.nic.in . It is the responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they meet the requisite eligibility criteria.

(b) Documents of the candidates will be verified to check eligibility when they report for counseling. Mode of counseling will be intimated subsequently. Civilian doctors will have to undergo medical examination by duly constituted medical board so as to assess their fitness for commissioning as per laid down criteria and will be admitted only if found fit.

(c) Candidates while reporting for counseling/admission have to bring following documents:-

- (i) 06 (Six) Passport size latest photographs.
- (ii) Copy of the NEET-SS 2017 Admit card
- (iii) NEET SS -2017 score card
- (iv) Copy of Class X/ SSLC/ ICSE certificate as valid certificate of proof of age.
- (v) Copy of University Mark Sheet of first to final MBBS examinations and Post-graduation course.
- (vi) Copy of Internship Completion Certificate.

(vii) Copy of Permanent/ provisional State Medical Council Registration Certificate of MBBS & Postgraduation course.

(viii) Copy of MBBS & Post-graduation Passing Certificate if degree has not been received.

(ix) Copy of Nationality Certificate/ Xerox copy of valid Passport/ Domicile Certificate/ Birth Certificate.

- (x) Copy of Attempt Certificate (MBBS & MD/ MS/ DNB as applicable).
- (xi) Copy of Transfer Certificate for non AFMC candidate.
- (xii) Copy of Migration certificate for Non MUHS Candidate.
- (xiii) Copy of Aaddhar card

(xiv) Sponsorship certificate in case of Medical Officers sponsored by Para Military Forces/ other Govt of India organization. Sponsor's certificate issued by the sponsoring authority, should be specific to one subject only and is mandatory requirement for the candidate to be considered for counseling in that subject only.

(xv) In case of Ex-AFMS/ SSC Officers, release order from Armed Forces Medical Services by DGAFMS / concerned Medical Directorate.

(xvi) Civilian candidates, if selected, will be required to execute a bond agreement to serve as Short Service Commission officer (SSC service) for 5 years with the Armed Forces Medical Services (Service liability) or pay an amount of **Rs 33 lacs (Rupees Thirty Three Lacs only**) to Govt of India if unwilling to join on successful completion of the course and subject to being offered the said commission as per **GOI letter No: PCIII/17436/DGAFMS/DG1D/1819/ 13/(a)/D (Medical) dated 15 January 2014.**
