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## ORDER:

Whereas, in pursuance of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dt. 12-8-2005 in Appeal (Civil) No. 5041 of 2005 filed by P.A. Inamdar Vs. State of Maharashtra (AIR 2005 SC 3226), and also discussions held with the Private Unaided Non-Minority Medical / Dental Colleges in the State of A.P. for the Super Specialty courses i.e., DM/MCH, a consensual arrangement was arrived in adopting the admission policy and Fee for the seats in Unaided Non-Minority Medical Colleges in the State in respect of Super Specialty courses.

- 2) And whereas, the State Government and the private managements of professional colleges, since then, having worked out periodically under consensual arrangements, providing for seat sharing, process of admissions and determination of fee structure; and said arrangements /consensual agreements, were given effect to by issuance of necessary notifications' by the state Government.
- 3) And whereas, an Memorandum of Understanding has been entered into to formalize the consensual agreement with the AP Private Medical and Dental Colleges Managements Association with regard to admission process and fixation of fee for the Super Speciality courses for the academic year 2017-2018.
- 4) In the MoU, it is also mentioned that in pursuance to the directions of the Govt., of India and Honourable High Court for the State of AP and the State of Telangana in W. P. No. 27162 of 2017 and batch, it is agreed that the admissions to DM and M. Ch courses in the State of AP shall be though a common national counseling conducted by Medical Admission Committee of DGHS for the year 2017-18.
- 5) In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, , the Director of Medical Education, AP while forwarding the MoU of Consensual Agreement between Government of Andhra Pradesh represented by Director of Medical Education and Andhra Pradesh Unaided Medical and Dental Colleges Managements Association represented by the Treasurer in the matter of Admissions to the Super Specialities Medical Courses in Private Unaided Medical Colleges, for the academic year 2017-2018, has requested to take necessary action in the matter.
- 6) The Government after elaborate discussions and consideration of materials placed before the authorities of the government as to the actual costs involved in imparting quality education and escalations in costs, increase in the University related fees and assessment of such costs, hereby fix the tuition fee as Rs. 24,00,000/- per annum for DM and M. Ch Courses. The above Fee structure is for one academic year. The same fee shall be charged for the remaining academic years of study.
- 7) The Government also hereby permit the colleges to increase the tuition fee by 5% every year towards cost escalation and that the institutions shall collect fee every year and the college may obtain Bank Guarantee for the remaining period of the course.

- 8) The college shall pay the stipend to the Super Specialty students as per the AP State Regulations.
- 9) As per the directions of the Government of India and Honourable High Court for the State of AP and the State of Telangana in W. P. No. 27162 of 2017 and batch, the Admissions to DM and MCh courses (Super Speciality Courses) in the state of AP shall be through a common national counselling conducted by Medical Admission Committee of DGHS for the year 2017-18.
- 10) The Registrar, Dr NTR University of Health Sciences shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
