NOTICE

Urgent Attention DME's// Directors of State Counselling Authorities of all states & UTs:

The Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) of DGHS is in receipt of many complaints from candidates that the states are not following schedule prescribed by NMC for their state quota UG counselling and some states have still not completed their Round-2 which should have been completed by 4th Sept., 2023.

In this regard, the competent authority of MCC has directed state counselling authorities to strictly follow the schedule and complete their counselling rounds as per schedule given below. The last date of joining in Round-3 for state quota UG counselling is 21.09.2023 after which the states are required to fill the data of all candidates who are **Holding a seat in state colleges.**

The list of candidates holding a seat in state should be uploaded on intramcc portal upto **22nd Sept., 2023** positively so that MCC can filter out such candidates before seat processing of Stray Vacancy Round to be conducted by MCC on 25th Sept., 2023. It is pertinent to mention that the filtering out of joined candidates before stray vacancy round is mandatory as per directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Contempt Petition© No. 289 of 2022 in W.P No. 223 of 2022 Shubhankar Patnaik Vs. K. Ramesh Reddy & Ors, failing which the matter can lead to litigations.
