HON'BLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF INDIA AND HIS COMPANION JUDGES OF THE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA

THE HUMBLE APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF APPLICANT/RESPONDENT - MEDICAL COUNCIL OF INDIA

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:

- 1. That the instant application is being filed by the Medical Council of India seeking modification of time Schedule for admission to M.B.B.S. course for academic year 2013-14.
- 2. That this Hon'ble Court vide its judgment dated 12.01.2005, laid down the time schedule, which is to be followed by the State Colleges, Institution and Private Colleges for admission in the Medical and Dental Courses. A copy of the judgment and order dated 12.01.2005 passed by this Hon'ble Court in the case of Mridul Dhar & Anr. Vs. Union of

Laddation, 2007 Ghadaga - What phot approval of Contra

Govt, by Medical Council of India under Section 33 of Indian Medical Council of India lays down the time schedule for holding counseling and admission to MBBS Course for All India quota, State Quota and private institutions. Regulation 7 (6) of Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997 provides that all authorities shall organize admission process in such a way that the classes commence from 1st August of each academic year. It has further been stipulated in the said regulation that the admission is to be completed by 30th September of each academic year. A copy of the Gazette notification dated 1st March, 2004 inserting the said clause and time schedule in Regulation of Graduate Medical Education, 1997 is annexed herewith and marked as ANNEXURE-A/2 (PAGE NO.3) TO33).

4. That it is submitted that Medical Council of India amended both Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997 and Postgraduate Medical Education Regulation, 2000 whereby it introduced the provision of Single Eligibility cum entrance Test named as National Eligibility-Cum-Entrance Test (for short NEET) for admission to MBBS and Postgraduate medical courses from academic year 2013-14. Copies of Gazette Notification amending Graduate Medical Education

Regulation, 1997 dated 21.12.2010 and 15.2.2012 are annexed herewith and marked as **ANNEXURE-A/3 Colly (PAGE NO.34 TO**41).

- 5. That it is submitted that the constitutional validity of NEET Regulations came to be challenged in writ petitions all over India. This Hon'ble Court was pleased to transfer all such cases before this Hon'ble Court.
- interim order dated 13.12.2013 in T.C. (C) No. 101 of 2012 and connected matters permitted Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India as well as States and Universities and other institutions to conduct their respective examination for admission to MBBS, BDS and Postgraduate Medical Courses and this Hon'ble Court further directed Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India, States, Universities and other institutions not to declare result of the said examinations until further order. A copy of the order of this Hon'ble Court dated 13.12.2013 passed in T.C. (C) No. 101 of 2012 and connected matters is annexed herewith and marked as ANNEXURE-A/4 (PAGE NO. 42.
- 7. That it is submitted that judgment in batch cases connected with T.C. (C) No. 98 of 2012 was reserved on 30th April, 2013.
- 8. That it is further submitted that on 13th May, 2013 this Hon'ble Court modified its earlier order dated 13th December, 2012 and allowed the publication of result of the

connected cases is annexed herewith and marked as ANNEXURE-A/5 (PAGE NO. 54 TO 7 6).

- 9. That it is submitted that CBSE conducted NEET examination for admission to MBBS courses and pursuant to the order of this Hon'ble Court, result of the same was declared.
- 10. That it is submitted that on account of introduction common entrance test for admission to MBBS course, online counseling, delay in completion of admission process in postgraduate medical courses, introduction of third round of counseling and pendency of cases before this Honb'ie Court challenging the validity of the Regulation, admission to MBBS Course is not likely to be completed as per the time schedule stipulated in judgment of this Hon'ble Court and in the Regulation and therefore, the same requires modification. It is stipulated both in the judgment and Regulation that classes of MBBS course in each academic course shall commence from 1st of August. However, in view of the above factors, classes in MBBS course can commence from 12th of August, 2013.
- 11. That it is submitted that the Central Government having regard to the above factors has, vide its letter dated 24th

 June, 2013 to the Medical Council of India, proposed to

modify the time schedule for conducting counseling for admission to MBBS Course for All India and State quota. It is relevant to mention here that as per Regulation of Medical Council of India, the counseling period for admission to MBBS Course in private institutions is identical to the counseling schedule for admission to the medical colleges of State Government. A copy of the letter of Government of India dated 24.6.2013 to the Medical Council of India suggesting modified time schedule is enclosed herewith and marked as **ANNEXURE-A/6 (PAGE NO.77TO 78).**

- 12. That it is submitted that the modification of time schedule is necessitated on account of aforesaid circumstances and modification of time schedule would not cause prejudice to students but it would be in the interest of students as it would ensure that the seats in Medical College do not remain unfilled. Moreover, last date of admission to MBBS Course in Medical Colleges which is 30th September of each academic year has not been changed and therefore, there would not be any mid-session admission or academic schedule is going to be affected at all except minor delay of 12 days in commencement of classes for academic year 2013-13.
- 13. That it is submitted that this Hon'ble Court in the case of Priya Gupta Versus State of Chhattisgarn reported in 2012(7) SCC 433 has provided for initiation of contempt in case of violation of the time schedule. The relevant

paragraphs of the said judgment are quoted hereinunder for ready reference:

"37. What is of greater significance is that this Court has not so far considered or stated as a principle, what consequences should follow where the Central Government, or the State Government or the Medical Council of India or the college itself, with impunity, violate the time schedule, regulations and order of merit to give admission to students in an arbitrary and nepotistic manner. Also, we must consider what preventive steps can be taken to avoid such repetitive and intentional defaults, as well as undue exploitation of the class of students. Admissions based on favouritism necessarily breach the rule of merit on the one hand, while on the other, they create frustration in the minds of the students who have attained higher rank in the competitive entrance examinations, but have not been admitted. We propose to specifically address this concern in this judgment.

47.1 Everybody, officers or authority who disobeys of avoids or fails to strictly comply with these directions stricto sensu shall be liable for action under the provisions of the Contempt of Courts Act. Liberty is granted to any interested party to take out contempt proceedings before the High Court having jurisdiction over such institution/state, etc."

Therefore, permission of this Hon'ble Court is required for modifying the time schedule.

14. That it is submitted that the Medical Council of India has filed I.A. No. 27-28 in Writ Petition No. 306 of 2004 seeking permission to modify the time schedule for admission to postgraduate medical courses for academic year 2013-14.

The prayer in the said application was confined to modification of time schedule for admission to postgraduate medical courses only. A copy of the application along with letter of Medical Council of India dated 22.5.2013 to the Central Govt. are annexed herewith and marked as ANNEXURE-A/7 (PAGE NO. 19 TO &6).

- 15. That it is submitted that this Hon'ble Court was pleased to modify the time schedule for admissions to postgraduate medical courses vide order dated May 28^{th,} 2013 permitting completion to admission process by 31st July, 2013. However, inadvertently, it came to be recorded in the order of this Hon'ble Court dated 28.5.2013 in I.A. No. 27-28 of 2013 that the modified time schedule will apply to MBBS also i.e. admission in MBBS is also required to be completed by 31st July, 2013. A copy of the order of this Hon'ble Court dated 28.5.2013 in I.A. No. 27-28 of 2013 is annexed herewith and marked as **ANNEXURE-A/8** (PAGE NO. 87 TO 89).
- 16. That it is submitted that this Hon'ble Court in the case of Mridul Dhar (Supra) has mentioned that the last date of admission in MBBS course is 30th September of each academic year. Besides, Regulation of MCI also provides for different time schedule for admission to MBBS course i.e. 30th September of each academic year is last date for admission to MBBS course. Therefore, the order of this Hon'ble Court dated 28.5.2013 in I.A. No. 27-28 of 2013

requires clarification to the extent that order of this Hon'ble Court dated 28.5.2013 in I.A. No. 27-28 is relating to admission to postgraduate medical courses only.

PRAYER

In view of facts stated above this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:

- (a) permit the applicant to modify the schedule for process of admission to MBBS course in All India quota and State quota/institution for academic year 2013-14 as per letter of Government of India dated 24.6.2013;
- (b) Pass such further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
