

NOTICE

All the candidates/colleges/institutes/universities are hereby informed that as per the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India there are only two round of online NEET Super Speciality counselling conducted by MCC/DGHS. However, some of the students approached Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for extension of online Super Speciality counselling but the same have been turned down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dated 22.09.2017 MA No.1037 in WRIT PETITION (C) NO.76/2015.

In reference to the MCI gazette notification No. MCI-18(1)/2017-Med./128371 clause 9A (2) and keeping in view of the above facts, MCC/DGHS would like to state that only Super Speciality seats allotments made by MCC/DGHS till second round of online counselling are valid and if any college/ institutes/universities had admitted the candidate at their own level beyond MCC counseling are invalid and such admission are liable to be cancelled.

It is essential to mention that the last date of admission/seat allotment in Super Speciality seats was 14.09.2017 as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and any admissions beyond this date are also invalid and seats of such candidates are likely to get cancelled.
